I happened to read the article "Phaco training - A learning experience" by Dr. Seema Behl et.al in Jul-Sept 2001 issue of our journal. It is a very informative article and gives a perfect picture as to how a phaco-training programme should be conducted; especially, criteria for selection of a case for phaco are laid down very well. It was surprising to note, however, that despite excluding the systemic problems, 5

patients still developed diabetic maculopathy within one month post-operatively, reducing the best corrected visual activity. This is an interesting finding and needs to be studied further. Also, it would be useful, in such articles to draw a Venn diagram while enlisting complications to know about concurrence of two or more complications.
